

**WILBERFORCE KISAMBA-MUGERWA** is a PhD holder in Agricultural Economics from Makerere University. He is currently the Executive Chairperson of the National Planning Authority in Uganda and also a Research Associate with Makerere Institute of Social Research. He was the 2009 spring semester; Visiting Professor for International studies in Rural Development at Williams College, Massachusetts USA. Before joining the National Planning Authority in Uganda, he served as a Division Director of International Service of National Agricultural Research (ISNAR) with the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI) based in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.

Before that Kisamba Mugerwa had held various Cabinet Ministerial positions in the Government of Uganda including the Ministry of Agriculture, Animal Industry and Fisheries. He was also elected Member of Parliament for 24 years until 2004 and was the first Chairman of Luweero District Council in Uganda. He has a strong background in research with particular interests in rural finance, land tenure and natural resources management; agricultural research for development, food security and rural development and governance in general. He has written and presented several professional papers in international conferences and some of them published.
